WHAT IS CAREER PREP?

In their last year at Clifton CDS, students from any CTE cluster have the option to take Career Preparation, which focuses on the skills and individualized transition support to find and maintain employment. In the classroom, students find and apply for jobs, create a resume, develop interviewing skills, and practice workplace communication. They also build independent living skills such as budgeting and accessing public transportation. Students spend most of their time engaged in work-based learning, either through school-organized internships or at individual jobs.

For students who obtain employment during the year (or are already employed), our Career Prep teachers can coordinate with employers to develop a work plan that will count towards class credit.

RISING SENIORS GOING INTO YEAR 3 AT CLIFTON

Students going into their 3rd year at Clifton have 3 options:

Year 3 (Practicum I or II) in their CTE Cluster

This is a good fit for students who want to continue learning and developing skills in their career cluster. This may include students who want to enroll in a technical school, join a trade union, or pursue advanced certificates and degrees in their field.

Career Prep

This is a good fit for any student interested in paid employment. This includes students interested in finding a job, students who are currently employed but are interested in changing jobs/advancing in the workplace, or students who are currently employed and need support to manage workplace expectations.

Year 3 AND Career Prep

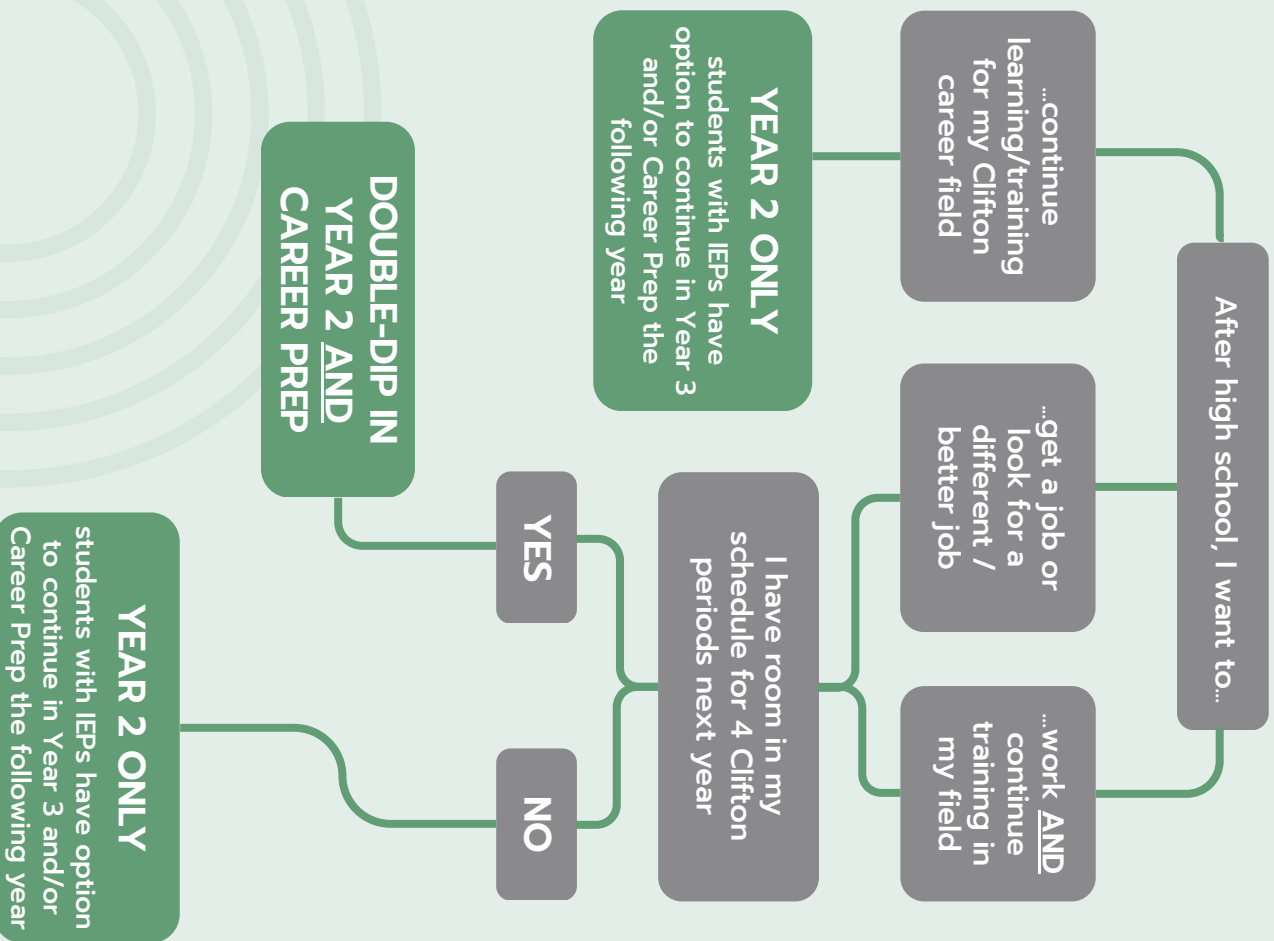
This option depends largely on flexibility in a student's schedule. "Double-dipping" at Clifton will take 4 periods.

RISING SENIORS GOING INTO YEAR 2 AT CLIFTON

Students going into their 2nd year at Clifton will take Year 2 in their CTE cluster.

Students who have room in their schedule may also choose to "double-dip" in Year 2 AND Career Prep.
